*For guaranteed Selection by Grades, subjects need to be 20-credit Stage 2 Tertiary Admission Subjects (TAS). Students also need to achieve a minimum ATAR of 50. Some degrees also have prerequisites and other eligibility criteria for entry that you'll still have to meet. This is for both guaranteed Selection by Grades and Selection Rank.

Armed with your list of preferences, you can now apply to study at UniSA through the SATAC website. If you need help with your application, check out our self-help resources.

TIP

Remember to list your preferences in order of what you're most passionate about, not based on your ATAR. How you list your preferences is how SATAC will provide offers (by working down the list). In your SATAC application, make sure you use your own mobile number and a personal email address – one you can access after high school.

And, don't forget to apply before the early application deadline to avoid a late fee.

Year 12 results are finalised in mid-December. Check to see if you're eligible for adjustment factors (bonus points) and confirm your Selection Rank (ATAR, including adjustment factors), by visiting SATAC's self-service portal. Then, give our Future Student Enquiries team a call to talk through your study options.

You could be eligible for UniSA's Guaranteed Entry into your preferred degree (see page 1).

It's also important to confirm your preferences by the change of preference deadline to be considered for an offer.
