CARE INSTRUCTIONS



- Use *cold* to warm water.
- No harsh cleaning products. **No Bleach**
- **Care for my print**, turn me inside out so my ink doesn't get stressed.
(Embroidery is tough, so can handle the rumble with other clothes).
- **Hang dry**. Dryers can shrink and damage my looks.
- **Sort your laundry**. (If I'm dark, don't put me with those lights).
Wash separately from velcro.
- **Don't iron my ink or embroidery**. Use a low setting so it doesn't destroy the image.
- **Don't leave the garment damp**, coloured panels may bleed and ruin my looks if you leave damp.
- **Do not** leave damp in the washing machine as it may affect prints and dyes in fabric.
- **PLEASE refer to the care label attached to the garment**

JUST A LITTLE KNOW-HOW IN THE CARE DEPARTMENT

Screen printing sits on top of the fabric, so abrasive surfaces such as velcro and backpacks can irritate and even damage my print. Sublimation and embroidery are the tough guys here, so they're ok.

I may not last forever, but caring for me properly during the laundry process prolongs my life.



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
