I am writing to inform you Doxa is now inviting applications from students for our 2019 Employment Pathways programs, Cadetship and Future Insights. These programs support talented young people from challenging backgrounds to progress through education, gain employability skills and industry connections so that they are prepared for the workplace.

Doxa is a Victorian not-for-profit that provides programs that offer positive life experiences, education opportunities and employment pathways. While everyone is different, this may include financial hardship, trauma, newly arrived and refugee young people, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people.

This letter details the Future Insights and Cadetship programs and we would be grateful for your assistance in passing on information relating to these programs to your students. The programs are free-of-charge.

Cadetship Program

The Cadetship is a three to five-year program. It is more than a scholarship or internship, it's a holistic approach to the development of a young person through their education. As part of the program, Cadets have access to:

- Financial assistance for living expenses and educational resources
- Up to eight weeks work placement each year
- Professional development training
- Peer and Industry Mentors
- Networking opportunities

Future Insights Program

Future Insights is a one-year program for 1st Year University students to support them to adapt to University life and to turbocharge their career path. The program is delivered via a series of development workshops, offering:


- Support to find a Mentor
