University of Sydney Creative Arts Special Admission Scheme (CASAS)

Did you know you can apply to get an early offer from the Con before you get your ATAR? If you've got the talent and the dedication, we want you. The Creative Arts Special Admissions Scheme offers talented Year 12 students a chance to receive an early offer to study music based on their audition and academic performance in Year 11 and 12 so far, prior to getting an ATAR. The degrees available under the admissions scheme are:

- Bachelor of Music
- Bachelor of Music (Composition)
- Bachelor of Music (Performance)

If you are a HSC student in NSW, you must do the following:

- Apply to UAC by the relevant September Round 1 deadline.
- List your chosen music degree as your first preference.
- Meet the audition/portfolio and interview requirements in the July or September rounds of auditions.

You are encouraged to apply in the July round of auditions (UAC August Round 1) where you will be able to audition live and have a chance to secure an early offer before submitting HSC work or undertaking exams. For most NSW Year 12 HSC students, no separate application is required, and your Year 11 and 12 results and predicted ATAR will be obtained automatically through UAC by the Sydney Conservatorium of Music.

Did you know you can apply to get an early offer from Sydney College of the Arts before you get your ATAR? If you've got the talent and the dedication, we want you. The Creative Arts Special Admission Scheme offers talented Year 12 students a chance to receive an early offer to study visual arts based on their portfolio and academic performance in year 11 and 12 so far, prior to getting an ATAR. You must be a domestic student, currently undertaking a recognised Year 12 qualification to apply. All offers will require you to complete your high school qualification. The scheme does not apply to non-recent school leavers.

The Law Admission Test (LAT) is a professionally designed and scored selection test developed by the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) to assess the types of aptitudes and skills that are critical to success in tertiary Law programs. These aptitudes and skills include the ability to think critically, to analyse information, and to organise and express ideas in a clear and fluent way. The LAT is a computer-based test developed by the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) in conjunction with UNSW Law & Justice and is currently used for selection into undergraduate level programs in Law at UNSW Sydney.

NIDA offers a range of scholarships to support students to attend NIDA, helping to cover student living expenses. NIDA is committed to building a diverse community of students and strongly encourages applications from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, people who are Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) and people with a disability. Government financial support is also available to some NIDA students. Information about this can be found on the Services Australia website, including information about the relocation scholarship. Eligible students entering their first, second or third year in a full-time Higher Education course (Bachelor or Master of Fine Arts degrees) can apply for a scholarship at the beginning of the academic year. To apply for scholarships at NIDA, you need to first submit your course application form(s) to study with us. Once they are completed, you can also submit your scholarship application form. There is one form, which is used for all scholarships. After your audition or interview, if you are offered a place at NIDA, we will then assess your scholarship application and be in touch.
