RELIGIOUS EDUCATION / INQUIRY

Concept/Big Idea: Adaptation

Big Question/Throughline: How can we adapt? Unit understandings questions:

- What are some strategies and dispositions we can use to help us adapt to different situations?
- How can adapting to new situations have both positive and negative outcomes for people?
- How can everyone learn to adapt to new situations and circumstances in their lives?

Religious Education Guiding Questions:

READING AND VIEWING

<u>ENGLISH</u>

Poetry-Metaphor, similes and personification and using these techniques in our writing. **Paraphrasing**-Note-taking skills, summarising, key facts, paraphrasing

Comparing and Analysing texts- similarities and differences in texts about the same topic or by the

same author and evaluating effective writing techniques

Continuing to focus on the CAFE strategies of Comprehension, Accuracy when decoding words, Reading with Fluency and Expression.

WRITING

Narrative - Using the seven steps to writing success approach-How can we write an exciting narrative that engages the reader?

Poetry-Writing different styles of poetry that engage the reader, using metaphor, similes and personification in some of the poems.

Information Texts-How to use the seven steps approach to writing an interesting information text with key facts.

GRAMMAR-Understand how nouns groups, phrases, adjectives and adverbs can be expanded. -Various punctuation and editing skills

Presentation/Speaking skills

-communicating with clarity and expression during presentations such as I-Time or group presentations -listening to others points of view in a respectful manner

-Understand the uses of objective and subjective language and bias

-Ask and answer clarifying questions during presentations

Multiplication and division strategies

-Students will investigate and use efficient mental and written strategies when multiplying and dividing.

-Geometric reasoning and transformation, angles, how a shape looks when it's position changes.
