News from the University of Melbourne

Bachelor of Science

Maybe you've always known that you wanted to be a marine biologist. Or perhaps you're still deciding whether you want to be an engineer or a geologist. A doctor or a vet? A data scientist or a physicist? A chemist or a psychologist?

The [Bachelor of Science](#) is a pathway to all these careers, and hundreds more. With more than 40 majors on offer, students can select from the full range of *science, biomedicine, mathematics, engineering, and IT subjects*.

The Bachelor of Science is a **3-year degree**, in which students complete **24 subjects**. Of the 24 subjects, some will contribute to their **major** (chosen specialisation), some will be **science electives** (other science subjects), and some will be **breadth** (non-science) subjects. Diploma in Languages

Learn a language by studying the Diploma in Languages alongside your undergraduate degree at Melbourne. You will demonstrate a master of both the oral/aural and written/reading skills to communicate effectively in another language and appreciate its cultural contexts.

The [Diploma in Languages](#) is offered as a concurrent diploma qualification taken at the same time as an undergraduate degree. It usually adds a year onto a student's study, but fast track options are available with approval to complete both your degree and the diploma in three or three-and-a-half years of full-time study.

News from Federation University **New Bachelor of Cognitive Enterprise**

Federation University is introducing the new 3-year [Bachelor of Cognitive Enterprise](#) which has been created in response to future industry needs. Co-designed with IBM®, this course provides students with foundations, knowledge, and skills to deal with technological and strategic demands of contemporary and future business settings.

A Cognitive Enterprise is a business that combines the disruptive technologies including AI, Blockchain, Internet of Things (IoT), 5G and Edge Computing with innovative processes and data, to enhance customer experience and gain competitive advantage.

Students who study this degree will not only attain the bachelor's degree but, through the partnership with IBM® will see them job-ready by earning IBM® Digital Badges (certifications) in Blockchain and AI during the degree. New Criminal Justice Management Degree

Make a difference to the lives of people impacted by the criminal justice system through a career in youth justice, community justice, police, government departments, courts, prisons, corrections, or community-based agencies developing and implementing projects to support people who are either at risk of or who have offended. Develop skills in management, strategic planning, project management, policy and grant writing in addition to a comprehensive understanding of the criminal justice system.

The [Bachelor of Criminal Justice Management](#) is ideal for people who have a passion for and interest in developing and managing projects. Students will develop an understanding of the criminal justice system, criminal justice agencies, victims and offenders and also the skills to undertake project and strategic management, communications, grant application writing, manage people and develop creative and innovative solutions to social and justice related problems.

Students are also prepared to be job-ready through a Work Integrated Learning program undertaken in the third year of the degree. Students get to experience criminal justice in the real-world with a placement that responds to real world issues.
