Looking for a great e-book to read?

Read anywhere, anytime, for free. Just download our e-books and start reading. Axis360 has a huge range of e-books for all tastes, including bestsellers, classics, children's books



and non-fiction. Simply download the Axis360 app, create an account, search or browse for titles, then download and read your book. Keep the book for 21 days (with one renewal if it's not reserved) and reserve other books for free. Tip: create a Wish List for books you want to read later. The latest e-books for adults, teens and children are now also being added to the BorrowBox app, so take a look.

Is listening to a book your thing? On a solo walk or lying in bed in the dark? Listen up! Borrow, download and enjoy e-audiobooks with the BorrowBox library app. This collection contains bestsellers, latest titles, junior books and non-fiction books. Download the BorrowBox App and login to search, download and listen to your book. Keep the book for 21 days (with two renewals if it's not reserved) and reserve other books for free. Tip: use the My Reading List to create a list of books to listen to later.

Are magazines your relaxing read?

Read the latest Australian and international magazines online with RB Digital or catch up with back issues you missed. Download the app, create an account and then browse or search for a magazine to download and read. Flip through the magazines — just like the real thing. You can keep the magazine for as long as you want or delete it when you have finished reading. You'll never be caught short again without a glossy magazine to read. Make good purchasing decisions with the Flipster app for access to *Choice* magazine online. Simply download the app and login to read the current issue and all issues of *Choice* back to December 2014.

Stream and watch movies anytime

Kanopy is an on-demand video streaming service offering Australian, indie and foreign language films, television series, documentaries, blockbuster movies and children's movies. Simply create an account to start watching. You have 10 video credits per month and three days to watch a film once you click play.

Listen to free, legal music with Freegal

Freegal gives you access to all types of music, from Ariana Grande to Beethoven and everything in between. Download the Freegal app and login to start streaming or downloading music, watch music videos or create playlists.

Newspapers from around the world

PressReader provides access to Australian and international newspapers and magazines from 100 countries. Download the app, create an account and start reading the daily news from all over the world.

BusyCode

BusyCode teaches primary aged children the fundamentals of how to create, run and debug simple programs. There are five areas in BusyCode, each progressing in difficulty. In each area there are three activity types

— tutorials, challenges and projects. Suitable for children aged six to 11.

CoderZ

CoderZ is an online educational environment that improves students' 21st century skills while they learn coding and have fun programming their own virtual cyber robot. Suitable for ages nine to 17.
