

As from 8 November 2021 update on changes to CoronaVirus

Places of Worship

A place of worship is open to all members of the public regardless of their vaccination status. People attending churches will need to observe a two square metre rule, with the exception of people from the same household. Check in with the QR Code or via a written register is still required and face masks must continue to be worn.

Funerals

Attendance at Funerals is restricted to the 1 person per 2 square metres social distancing guidelines. Someone who is not fully vaccinated can only attend a small funeral or memorial service. A small funeral or memorial service is one with a maximum of 10 people in attendance, not including the person conducting the service and anyone necessary for the conduct of the service.

Singing

Singing is also allowed those in the congregation who are fully vaccinated however they must be wearing a mask. Singing without masks by up to 10 fully vaccinated lead singers/choir who are socially distanced remains in place.

Weddings

Attendance at weddings it is restricted to the 1 person per 2 square metres social distancing guidelines. All guests attending a wedding must be fully vaccinated except for small wedding services. A small wedding service is a wedding with a maximum of 11 people in attendance being the people getting Married, the celebrant; 2 witnesses; a person to record the service; and 5 additional guests. Those in the process of being married do not have to wear masks, the attendees do.
