Year 3 to Year 6 students return

Tuesday is looming as an exciting day for all when all our students will be back at School. Our F-2 Families have had two weeks to transition back to onsite learning. Now it's time to welcome back our Year 3 to Year 6 students.

A reminder that all of our Year 3 to Year 6 students need to return with all of their belongings. We will have staff on hand to assist with tubs and extra heavy bags as the needs arise.

Access to the school

At the start of the day children can enter the school grounds between 8.30am until 9.00 am. The gates will be locked at 9.00am.

A reminder that students with Surnames beginning A-K enter school via the Chute St gate. Our students with surnames beginning with L-Z will enter via the Barkly St gate. There are pink coloured crosses to assist families with social distancing outside the school. Wendy Sullivan and I will be at the gates to provide a warm welcome each day and a serve of sanitizer for each student.

At the end of the day, A-K students are released at 3.00pm and L-Z students released at 3.15pm. Again, staff will supervise this process and Wendy and I will man the gates ensuring no one leaves the grounds who shouldn't, saying farewell and offering sanitiser to all on departure.

Technology Returns

Please ensure all technology borrowed during remote learning times is returned tomorrow, as these devices will need to be cleaned and sanitised here at school prior to going back into general circulation.

Drink Bottles

Students will also require a refillable drink bottle, full on arrival at school, that can be filled if required during the day. The drink taps are not for the consumption of water at the moment.

What to wear

Winter uniform is in place now and due to increased fresh air flow in rooms, heaters will be on and if required, students will be permitted to wear a beanie or over jacket if they are feeling cool. Our staff will support students with this. Please ensure any garment worn to school is labelled.

We look forward to our students returning on Tuesday for the remainder of the term - I'm sure they are looking to reconnect with their teachers and friends in person too.
