Physical Education

Prep



This term, the Preps will be continuing with hand-eye coordination skills of bouncing and catching, using tennis balls. They will practise these skills through learning how to play tennis.

Year 1 and 2

Years 3-6



This term, the Year 3-6 students will be learning the skills of cricket, tennis and softball. This will include hand-eye coordination; fielding, catching, throwing and striking skills. We will also be looking at tactics and game awareness skills.

The Year 3 and 4 students will be participating in a T-20 Cricket competition in Week 3 on Friday the 25th of October and the Year 5 and 6 students in Week 5 on Friday the 8th of November.

The students will also participate in the Galilee Swimming Carnival on Friday 22nd of November at MSAC.

Performing Arts

In **Prep, Year One and Year Two,** students will build on their knowledge of rhythm learnt through their singing and improvising on percussion instruments in Term 1. Students will use body percussion to learn basic rhythmic patterns of ta and ti ti and write and perform their own compositions.

In the second half of Term 4, students will learn a Christmas carol to perform at our whole school Carols by Candlelight.

In **Year Three and Year Four,** students will build on their knowledge of rhythm, dynamics and tempo learnt in Term 1. Year 5 will be working on embroidery sessions to be taken by Embroidery Artist and Tutor Jan-Maree while Year 6 students will work on a 'tree of life weaving'. Any overdue tasks will also be completed in readiness for our annual art show before students undertake our last unit for Term 4 which will be devoted to art activities based on the theme of Christmas.

L.O.T.E. (Italian)



Preps will share with others what they can express in Italian, and continue to build on reproducing the sounds of the Italian language through word, images, movement and song. They will participate in creating stories and imaginary tales. Topics will include IL Tempo, (The Weather), and Natale, (Christmas).

- **Year 1 & 2** will build on and reinforce what they can express in Italian, locate specific information in text that supports learnings and relate these to their own personal experiences. Topics will include IL Tempo/ Le Stagione, The Weather & The Seasons), and Natale, (Christmas).
- **Year 3 & 4** students will continue to develop their pronunciation, intonation and understanding of the Italian language. They will participate in listening to, view and read text, then use their knowledge to make meaning from the text. Topics will include, IL Mare (The Beach) and Natale, (Christmas).
- **Year 5 & 6** will listen to, view, read and create their own bilingual text to perform for a specific audience. They will use their understanding of intonations, pronunciation and grammatical knowledge to create meaning in Italian. Topics will include Reader's Theatre, IL Mare, (the Beach) and Natale (Christmas).
