Yan Yean Road Upgrade Stage 2 – Kurrak Road to Bridge Inn Road nightworks

We're upgrading Yan Yean Road between Kurrak Road and Bridge Inn Road to make it safer and easier to travel around Yarrambat and Doreen

We'll soon start work on the section of the project between Kurrak Road and Orchard Road. From mid-June, we'll work at night along Yan Yean Road to prepare the existing road for major construction and install concrete safety barriers. Works are also in progress along Bridge Inn Road and Doctors Gully Road to move underground services.

What we will be doing and when

From **Sunday 14 June to Friday 10 July**, we'll work between Sundays and Thursdays **from 7pm to 6am each night** to prepare Yan Yean Road for major construction. During this time, we'll complete works to improve the condition of the existing road. We'll also install safety barriers along the roadside to create protected work zones for our crews.

Works will include:

- repairing potholes and strengthening asphalt to make the existing road fit for construction traffic
- removing kerbs and medians to create breaks between separated lanes
- widening the road shoulder to make room for safety barriers
- locating underground services
- soil and ground investigations
- installing signage and line marking.

Once the safety barriers are in place, traffic will continue to travel along the existing Yan Yean Road while our crew builds the new lanes behind the barriers. When the new road sections are complete, traffic will switch to use the new lanes while we rebuild the older road surface.

Because Yan Yean Road curves through the road reserve, some sections of the new road will be built to the east of the existing road, while others will be built to the west, depending on the location.

From **Monday 15 June to Friday 17 July**, we'll also work at night between **7pm and 9am** along Bridge Inn Road, Bridge Inn Service Road, Yan Yean Road and Doctors Gully Road to move underground services to build the new section of Bridge Inn Road that will connect to the new signalised intersection.

What you can expect

We'll work on different sections of Yan Yean Road between Kurrak Road and Orchard Road each night, as our crews move along the project area.

When we work near you, you may notice increased noise, lighting and construction movements, including trucks, machinery, and traffic management being set up and removed each night. We'll plan our works to minimise disruption wherever possible.

We need to work closely with utility providers to relocate services. Temporary service interruptions to private properties may occur at times. If this impacts you and your property, your utility provider will notify you ahead of time.

Some of our works are weather-dependent and can only be completed in dry weather or may be impacted by unexpected ground conditions. If we need to reschedule, we'll let you know by email and SMS updates to subscribers, and on-road signage.

Changes to the way you travel

Night works

Around the Yan Yean Road, Bridge Inn Road and Doctors Gully Road roundabout

Short traffic holds will be in place along Bridge Inn Road, Bridge Inn Service Road, Yan Yean Road and on Doctors Gully Road approaching the roundabout for several nights from **Monday 15 June to Friday 17 July** between **7pm and 9am**.

Doctors Gully Road will be reduced to one lane near the roundabout continuously from **9.30am Monday 15 June** until **3pm Wednesday 24 June**. There will be traffic management in place to guide drivers through the works area.

Kurrag Road to Bridge Inn Road

Road closures and changed traffic conditions will be in place overnight on Yan Yean Road between Kurrag Road and Bridge Inn Road from **Sunday 14 June to Friday 10 July**.

From **7pm to 9pm each night and 5am to 6am each morning**, short traffic holds will be in place on sections of Yan Yean Road. While there will be minor traffic delays of **5 minutes**, drivers will still be able to travel along Yan Yean Road as normal.

Later in the night, between **9pm and 5am each night**, Yan Yean Road will be closed between Kurrag Road and Bridge Inn Road. Drivers who would normally travel through the area will detour via Kurrag Road, Plenty Road and Bridge Inn Road, with delays of up to **20 minutes** expected, and an additional **5 minutes** when traffic management is in place at the Bridge Inn Road roundabout.

If you live on Yan Yean Road or on a side road accessed from Yan Yean Road, you'll still be able to reach your home using various detours. The detour you use will depend on where you live. Scan the QR code for more information and to see detour maps.

<p>East of Yan Yean Road between Bridge Inn Road and Youngs Road (e.g. Bannons Lane, Golf Links Drive, Laurie Street)</p>	<p>Residents will need to access Yan Yean Road from the Bridge Inn Road side of the closure, detouring via Doctors Gully Road and Charles Sturt Drive to access Laurie Street and Bannons Lane, and detouring via Eisemans Road and Youngs Road to reach Yan Yean Road.</p> <p>Residents directly on Yan Yean Road between Youngs Road and Bridge Inn Road will be escorted through the work area to their properties from Youngs Road.</p>

Area	Access between 9pm and 5am
West of Yan Yean Road between Bridge Inn Road and Jorgensen Avenue (e.g. Garden Road, Orchard Road, Jorgensen Avenue)	Residents will need to access Yan Yean Road from the Bridge Inn Road side of the closure, detouring via Garden Road to access Serle Street, Vidler Ave and Jorgensen Avenue.
Yan Yean Road between Youngs Road and Ironbark Road, including Ashley Road	<p>From 14 June to 28 June, detour either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • from the Kurrak Road side of the closure via Faneco Road, Pioneer Drive, and Ironbark Road • from the Bridge Inn Road side of the closure via Doctors Gully Road, Charles Sturt Drive, Bannons Lane, Eisemans Road and Youngs Road <p>From 29 June to 10 July</p> <p>Residents will need to access Yan Yean Road from the Bridge Inn Road side of the closure, detouring via Doctors Gully Road, Charles Sturt Drive, Bannons Lane, Eisemans Road and Youngs Road. Traffic controllers will escort residents through the work area to their properties from Youngs Road.</p>

Long-term changes

Once the safety barriers are in place, speeds will be reduced to 60km/h between Kurrak Road and Jorgensen Avenue, and to 40km/h within the school zones at Yarrambat Primary School and Plenty Valley Christian College. There will also be some changes to side streets on Yan Yean Road for approximately 18 months, until late 2027.

Ironbark Road

We'll close a section of footpath on the eastern side of Yan Yean Road between Ironbark Road and Youngs Road. Pedestrians will need to use a temporary pedestrian crossing to cross Yan Yean Road to use the footpath on the western side of the road, before crossing back at the Ironbark Road traffic lights.

We'll also realign the lanes at the intersection to make room for works areas. The left and right turn lanes from Ironbark Road to Yan Yean Road will be combined into one lane, and a portion of the overtaking lane next to the bus bay on Ironbark Road near the intersection will be closed.

Ashley Road

We'll combine the left and right turn lanes from Ashley Road to Yan Yean Road into one lane to make room for construction works.

Golf Links Drive

We'll close the right turning lane from Yan Yean Road into Golf Links Drive to make room for construction barriers on the side of the road. Drivers heading to Golf Links Drive will need to detour by turning right into Bannons Lane and using Jeffrey Drive.
