Description of Excursion:

On Thursday 28 September 2023 during the Holiday Program children and educators will be going to the Palace Dendy Cinema, 26 Church St Brighton. **Departure from Ormond Primary School will be between 8:30 to 10am**, returning approx. 2pm. To get to the cinema the children and educators will be using the **Victorian Public Transport System**. To get to the Cinema the children and educators will walk down Jean St towards McKinnon Rd, Ormond to catch **the 626 Middle Brighton Bus – Chadstone via McKinnon & Carnegie to Middle Brighton**. The children and educators will disembark the bus at the Church St/St Andrews St Bus Stop and walk across Church St to the Cinema. At the cinema the children will watch a movie and will be able to consume food and drink that has been pre-approved by their parents prior to the day. After the movie the children and educators will walk to the Middle Brighton Station/Male St Brighton to catch the 626 Middle Brighton Bus – Chadstone via McKinnon & Carnegie to Chadstone, disembarking at Anne St/McKinnon Rd Ormond. At this time the children and educators will walk down Anne St, towards McKinnon Rd, turning right onto McKinnon Rd, continue along McKinnon Rd for until reaching **Ormond Primary School approximate return time of 2pm**.

Children will learn basic road safety skills, how to interact in the community, to be social independent as well as developing social interaction skills.

Student behaviour
