

Swimming Instructor Training Program Funded Training and Employment Opportunity

The Department of Education is offering training to students to become a Swimming Instructor. Training is free and is an opportunity for students to obtain an accredited Swimming Instructor and CPR qualification.

Who can register?

Students who are at least 17 years of age. Students do not require a minimum level of swimming stage to be eligible for the course, however they must be confident in the water.

What does it involve?

- Attend one-day face-to-face course.
- Complete up to 30 hours of self-paced on-line learning.
- Participate in industry training.

Student Transition to Employment with the Department

The Department will support students to transition to employment for VacSwim and Interm swimming programs through ongoing support and mentoring. It will also cover the costs of relevant screening including Working with Children Check and Department of Education Nationally Coordinated Criminal History Check.
