#### **CSEF** eligibility

#### Criteria 1 - Eligibility

Government or non-government Victorian primary or secondary school must: To be eligible for the fund, a parent or carer of a student attending a registered

- on the first day of Term one, or
- on the first day of Term two
- a) Be a holder of one or more of the eligible financially-means tested cards  $\mathbf{OR}$  be a temporary toster parent, and
- b) Submit an application to the school by the due date
