We went into one of the nursing labs at the <u>University of Technology Sydney</u> to see what their nursing students were working on and what you can expect if you're looking to study nursing here.

Within this 360 virtual tour, we make three stops.

- **1. Basic life support**: Students practise their nursing skills on manikins and other medical technologies before implementing them in real life situations.
- **2. Physical assessment**: Manikins range from newborn to adult.
- **3. Vital signs monitoring:** Nursing and midwifery students also learn in role play scenarios, sometimes playing the patient themselves.
