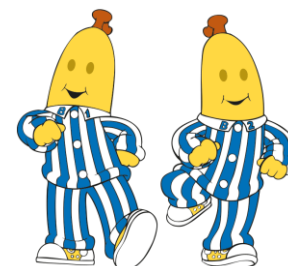
6. Ruby left home for school at 7:58. She arrived at school at 8:32. How many minutes did it take her to travel to school?
