


# Parent Guide to Seesaw at St. Michael's

#### HOW TO LOG-IN TO SEESAW


- When logging in, you will have the option to access Seesaw via an app or using an internet browser
- If you are using the website, please type 'Seesaw' into your browser's search bar or enter the link -<a href="https://app.seesaw.me/#/login">https://app.seesaw.me/#/login</a>
- Please click 'I'm a Family Member' to continue



- From here, you will need to enter your log-in details and click Family Sign In
- If you are new, you will need to create a Family Account by clicking 'I'm a Family Member' and continue to follow the prompts and create an account on the following page





## HOW TO ADD YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN



- When logged in, you will be taken to the Home page where you will be able to navigate your child/children's work
- If you cannot see your child's work you will then need to click on '+ Add Student's Journal'


- You will then need to use a QR Code or Link/URL (We usually send a URL at St. Michael's)
- Follow the steps provided by Seesaw, as seen below





- You should receive an email or text as seen below to accept the invitation to view your child's journal

 Once complete, you should be directed to your home page where you will be able to see your child's journal





## **PRIVACY**

The only people who can access or see your child/children's work are teachers, the student and you. If you would like anyone else to see your child's work, your child's teacher can invite them if you provide their email address. Up to 10 people can be connected and only those people can see your child's work.


#### MAKING COMMENTS/GIVING FEEDBACK
