2026 Annual Tuition Fee

At St Mary of the Cross MacKillop, our primary focus is for every child to flourish. To continue providing the high-quality education and supportive environment your children deserve, we must maintain a strong financial foundation capable of adapting to increasing costs across many areas of our school operations, as well as a changing, broader education sector funding environment.

Our tuition fees at St Mary of the Cross MacKillop are also influenced by the Commonwealth Department of Education's calculation of our community's ability to financially contribute to the operating costs of our school, known as the Capacity-to-Contribute, or CTC, which is reviewed annually.

To ensure that we can continue to deliver a personalised, high-quality education that is responsive to the diverse interests and academic, social and emotional needs of our students, it is necessary to adjust our fees in 2026.

2026 Fee Structure

• Annual Tuition Fee: \$2,145

An increase of \$75 (approximately \$1.44 per week) on 2025 fees.

• Curriculum Levy: \$555

An increase of \$10 on 2025 fees.

This levy supports a wide range of learning experiences and essential classroom resources, including, excursions, incursions, bus transport and interschool sport, consumables, library books, photocopying and all stationery, other resources such as student Chromebooks and iPads, art supplies, STEM materials, sports equipment, and educational materials.

• Building Fund Contribution: \$250

This contribution to the School Capital Fund has been reviewed for 2026 to support the upcoming construction of our new school building. This project, partly funded by the Capital Grant awarded in 2024, is scheduled to commence in 2026.

Additional Charges

For 2026, these charges will be issued at the beginning of the school year to allow families sufficient time to understand and plan for the total cost of these activities.

• Swimming Levy: \$80 per student

Students Year 3 & 4 will participate in the 2026 Swimming Program designed to build students' confidence in the water, develop core swimming techniques and teach vital water-safety skills to support their safety in and around aquatic environments. It also contributes to their overall physical development, resilience and wellbeing.

This Program is partly funded by Government grants, therefore the cost to the families hasn't changed in 2026.







• Sacrament Levy: \$50 per student

The Sacrament Levy applies to students in Year 3 (Reconciliation), Year 4 (First Communion) and Year 6 (Confirmation) and supports the costs of program resources, retreat activities and parish celebrations that contribute to students' spiritual development.

Camp Levy:

School camps are an important part of our learning program and support independence, resilience, teamwork and personal growth. Camp levies have increased slightly due to rising provider and venue costs, including transport, accommodation and program facilitation. We continue to work closely with providers to secure the most competitive rates while ensuring high-quality learning experiences and student safety.

 - One-day outdoor education experience
 - Includes meals and supervised activities
- · Year 5 Don Bosco Camp \$330
 - One-night beach experience
 - Includes accommodation, meals and supervised water and safety activities
- Year 6 Camp Campase Downs \$450
 - Two-night outdoor adventure program
- Includes accommodation, meals and a wide range of resilience and leadership-focused activities
