Instrumental and Vocal Music Tuition Expressions of Interest 2021

Monivae College recognises the importance of learning a musical instrument as a part of a child's holistic education. As a school, we are aware that there have been barriers to participating in this Co-curricula program and this year we have addressed this by subsidising the cost of music lessons to families.

We are seeking expressions of interest from students who would like to learn a musical instrument in 2021 to assist us in planning our staffing and program.

The program will commence in term 2, provided sufficient interest for each instrument is received.

Who can participate?

This is an inclusive program, and all students are welcome to participate.

Students do not need to have prior musical experience as our Instrumental Music staff are highly qualified and experienced. Lessons can be tailored for beginners as well as those returning to the program.

The program:

Music lessons will operate during the timetabled school day and each student will be allocated a 30 minute individual or group lesson.

Lessons will rotate each week to ensure that the student doesn't miss the same class.

Where possible, VCE students will be given the opportunity to have a lesson during their private study periods.

Each student will receive 8 weekly lessons per term, and they will be automatically re-enrolled each term unless notification to cease lessons is received.

Students that enrol in the program will need to commit to the program for a minimum of a term.

Fees and Lessons:

Each lesson will be subsidised by the College.

Lessons will be half hour in length and the cost to families will be:

\$ 20 per lesson for individual lessons

\$ 10 for group lessons of 2-3 students. (please see the list of applicable instruments)

Students can organise their own group lesson or the Head of Music will create a group based on similar needs and abilities.

Fees will be added to school accounts at the start of each term, therefore, money will not need to be brought to school for each lesson.

Current Year 7 Students:

Students in Year 7 this year will receive tuition free of charge on a Concert Band instrument when they complete the Year 7 music.

As year 7 Music is a semester subject, year 7's can also participate in this program in addition to Year 7 Music.

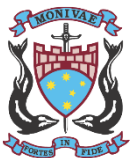
They can choose to undertake an additional instrument or to continue with the instrument that has been issued in year 7 music.

Instrument Hire:

The school has a supply of instruments for hire that are available only to students having lessons at Monivae College. Instrument hire is charged at \$100 per year and is added to your school account at the start of the school year.
