Who is Peter Lalor ?

Peter Lalor was an Irish man who was born to be a leader of the Eureka stockade, of Ballarat, Victoria.

Lalor was the son of a Home Rule supporter and landowner, and he was trained as a civil engineer in Ireland. In the mass migration that followed the great Irish famine in the mid-19th century, Lalor and one of his brothers immigrated to Australia in 1852 (three other brothers went to the United States).

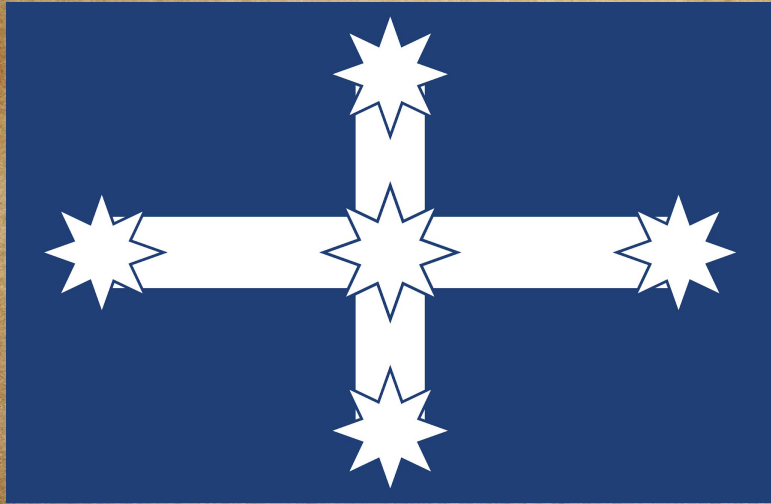

The miners gathered and marched to Bakery Hill. There, Irish miner Peter Lalor became the leader of the protest. Peter Lalor led the 1854 gold miners' uprising at the Eureka Stockade in Ballarat, Victoria, Australia. It was the most celebrated rebellion in Australian history. Later he became a politician.

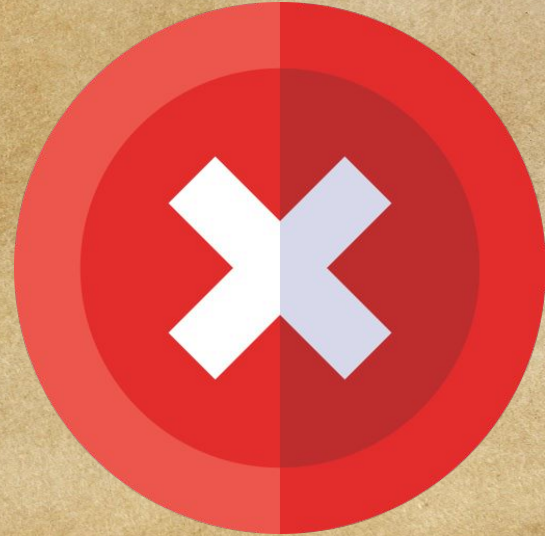
He served as postmaster general (1875), commissioner of trade and customs (1875, 1877–80), and speaker of the Assembly from 1880 to 1887

The rebellion led to a fairer goldfields system with the license replaced by the cheaper Miners Right, giving miners the right to vote. Many see this act as the first steps on the path to Australia's democracy.

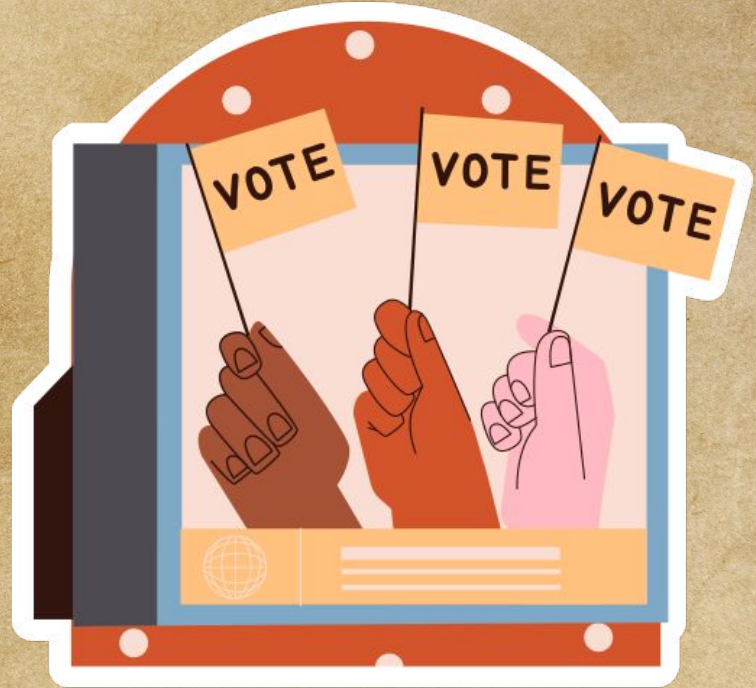

When did Peter Lalor become leader of the Eureka Stockade?

30 November 1854, as the police moved through the camp, the miners decided they'd had enough. The miners gathered and marched to Bakery Hill. There, an Irish miner Peter Lalor became the leader of the protest. Lalor led the miners to the Eureka diggings, where the men and women joined him in an oath: 'We swear by the Southern Cross, to stand truly by each other, and fight to defend our rights and liberties'.

February 1827 – 9 February 1889 was an Irish-Australian rebel and, later, politician who rose to fame for his leading role in the Eureka Rebellion, an event identified with the "birth of democracy" in Australia.

Lalor led the miners' opposition against the incompetent and often brutal administration of the goldfields, and was elected to lead the men in the armed uprising after the meeting on Bakery Hill.

Biography of Peter Lalor.

A biography of Peter Lalor

Peter Lalor is a Irish born leader of the Eureka stockade, and was born on February 5 1827. Peter Lalor was chosen to be the Leader of the eureka stockade and started rallying the miners to get ready for the battle of the 'Eureka stockade'.

Battle of The Eureka stockade.



Peter Lalor was born February 5 1827 Raheens, Queens, Country Ireland. When Peter was older Peter was at Carlow college and later on he moved to Trinity college to be a civil engineer .In 1852, Peter Lalor migrated to Australia to follow the Great Irish famine along with his 3 brothers who went to the United States. When Peter Lalor was at Australia, Peter Lalor worked at the Geelong railways in Victoria Australia.

in 1854 There was a rebellion called the 'Eureka Stockade' about to happen, because the people didn't think the miner's license was not fair and was not affordable for the People as it was 30 shillings a month. When it was time the miners organized a fight in November 30 for the miners license. All the Miners all chose and elected Peter Lalor on bakery hill as the leader of the uprising Eureka Stockade. During November 30 Peter Lalor led the miners to Bakery hill ready for the fight.

Once the miners were all ready they battled. Miners were fighting. You could hear the screaming, the yelling, and the suffering. The Eureka stockade only lasted 20 minutes and within 20 minutes 22 miners and 5 miners died. Next the devastating battle the miners license was reduced to 1 euro a month. After the Eureka stockade Peter Lalor get elected to the Victorian Legislative Council in November 1855 as Member for the new district of Ballarat, and remained in this role until March



Battle of the Eureka stockade

Peter Lalor lay sick unto death, he had been long suffering from an incurable disease. Lalor died at the age of 72 on February 5th in the Mater Hospital, just four days after being admitted with Covid-19, and was remembered as the leader of the Eureka Stockade .



Peter Lalor's Burial

Peter Lalor was born on February 5, 1827 in Ireland and migrated to Australia 1852. He became a miner and all the other miners chose him to be the Leader of The uprising Eureka stockade. Peter Lalor got sick of an incurable disease and died in 9 February 1889 Richmond.

Extra Information biography of the Eureka stockade

The Eureka stockade is a famous rebellion to cancel the miner's license because the people said, it was not affordable and fair. The person who led the Eureka stockade was Peter Lalor.



Miners License



On the 12th of February 1851 gold was discovered in Ballarat Australia. Everyone from all over the world came to Victoria to make a profit. On the 30th of November 1854 miners at Ballarat in Victoria swore to the Southern Cross flag at Bakery Hill. And was planning to have a battle to break the miners license.

.All of the miners chose Peter Lalor to be the leader of the Eureka stockade .At bakery hill an Irish miner named Peter Lalor became the leader of the Eureka stockade.The Eureka stockade was to break the rule of the miners license , because they complained it was to expensive and was not fair because, its is not give them the right to buy property or vote.

The Eureka stockade started peacefully but then it turned into a riot.It only lasted 20 minutes and in 20 minutes 22 miners and 5 soldiers died.The Eureka stockade is a key event of Australia's political systems and attitudes towards democracy equality.

After the Eureka Stockade the License fee was removed, replaced by an export duty and a nominal fee and it was only 1 euro per year miners rights. But still the people who had lost someone in the Eureka stockade still were sad.Peter Lalor also got injured in an assault by losing an arm in an assault.Soon after charges against the rebels leader were dropped.

The Eureka stockade significance is the first step on the path to Australia's democracy.

Conclusion

Peter lalor was born in February 5,1827.Peter lalor immigrated to Australia in 1852.He was a nice leader but others did not like him.In 1889 Peter lalor died of an incurable disease.
