

2025 SCHOOL IMMUNISATION PROGRAM – YEAR 7 (12-13 years of age)

Year 7 students (or age equivalent) are due for two vaccinations on the National Immunisation Program:

- Human Papillomavirus (HPV), 1 dose
- Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (whooping cough) booster, 1 dose

These vaccinations are provided free at school by Latrobe City Council under the National Immunisation Program and are recommended by the Department of Health. Immunisation can protect your child from serious diseases now and later in life.

You will receive a follow up email and/or text advising of your child's absence, and they can be caught up at any Latrobe City Council Community Immunisation Session, appointments made online: www.latrobe.vic.gov.au/immu. You may also make an appointment at a GP clinic.
