Change of Preference for IB Students January 2020

Results for IB students completing their course in November 2019 will be available to students Friday 3rd January. Students applying through VTAC to courses in Victoria will be able to login to the website at <u>http://www.vtac.edu.au/</u> from when you receive your results on that day until 4pm the next day (Saturday January 4) to make changes to preferences. Institutions will also have support available on that day to assist students. The table below shows the support available at a number of Victorian tertiary institutions. It would be better to ring institutions rather than email to ensure a quick response.

Change of preferences in other states:

New South Wales: The closing date for change of preferences for IB students is **midnight Sunday 5**th **January 2020**. You can log into your application and change your preferences up to that time. The UAC customer service team will be available at that time if you need help at all. Their number is 02 9752 0200 or 1300 275 822.

South Australia or NT: To cater for IB Diploma students, SATAC's participating institutions have approved an extension of the change of preference deadline for Undergraduate 2020 courses until 5.00pm (ACDT) on **Tuesday 7 January 2020.** Please note that some courses may display a message advising that applications for the course have closed. Adding, or changing the order of these courses will result in a message of 'Not eligible – late' being displayed against that preference in the online application due to the late preference change. IB Diploma students should be reassured that for courses added or reordered up until 5.00pm Tuesday 7th January 2020, SATAC will waive the late status against that preference. Students can contact SATAC on (08) 8224 4000 or 1300 138 440 (local call costs within Australia apply) if you have questions about changing preferences in their undergraduate application.

Queensland: IB students can make changes directly online by logging in to their QTAC online account. Applicants can make changes up until **4:30pm on Tuesday, 7 January 2020** and still be assessed in time for offers which are released at 8:30 AM on Wednesday, 15 January 2020. QTAC has a call number available which is **1300 467 822**.

Western Australia: IB students can make changes directly online by logging in to the TISC website. The deadline to change preferences for the January round of offers is **11pm (WA Time) Wednesday**, **8 January 2020.** You can also ring the call number which is (08) 9318 8000 which is available from 9am to 4:30pm (WA time), Monday to Friday.

Tasmania: Domestic students can change your preferences up until a month before Semester 1 starts (Semester 1 at the University of Tasmania starts on February 24). This is for all courses except MBBS (Medicine) for undergraduate courses. You should change your preferences as soon as possible after release of results however.
