NEW ZEALAND



Combine the beautiful, yet rugged scenery, the culture, traditions and warmth of the New Zealand people and their enthusiasm for all sports and you have the ideal destination for a tour.

All visitors to New Zealand must be carrying a passport that is valid for at least three months beyond your departure date. Australian passport holders do not require a visa to visit New Zealand.

The average temperature decreases the further you travel south and July is the coldest month of the year. The weather can change unexpectedly and we advise travellers pack accordingly.



FRI 12 APR - DAY 1

CHRISTCHURCH

The St. Pius tour party will depart from Sydney airport on your flight to Christchurch. After clearing customs and collecting your bags, your private coach will transfer the group to the Christchurch Top 10 Holiday Park, where you will stay for four nights. Tickets to the Crusaders v Highlanders game at AAMI park tonight are included.

SAT 13 APR - DAY 2

CHRISTCHURCH

After breakfast, transfer to Christchurch city for some sightseeing. In the afternoon, transfer to the location of your first game v St. Thomas of Canterbury. Spend some time with your hosts at the function after the game before returning to the holiday park.

SUN 14 APR - DAY 3

CHRISTCHURCH

Up early this morning for your day trip to Hanmer Springs. Depart Christchurch at 8am, arrive in Hanmer Springs at approximately 10am and enjoy a full day at the thermal pools. Return to Christchurch in the evening.



MON 15 APR - DAY 4 OAMARU

Depart Christchurch this morning and travel south approximately 3.5 hours to Oamaru. Play your second game of the tour this afternoon against St. Kevin's. Mix with your host school after the game. Grab some take away dinner this evening on the return trip to Christchurch.

TUE 16 APR - DAY 5 ROTORUA

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to Rotorua. Collect your rental vehicle and meet your coach driver who will transfer your group to Apumoana Marae. Tonight, you will stay on a Marae, the traditional meeting grounds of the Maori people. You will be welcomed onto the land in a "Powhiri" ceremony. Learn about the Maori culture and enjoy a traditionally cooked Hangi dinner



WED 17 APR - DAY 6 ROTORUA

This morning the group will visit Whakarewarewa Thermal Village for a tour and cultural show. Visit Blue and Green Lake for lunch before heading to Skyline Rotorua for your afternoon activity. Ride the Gondola and race down the mountain on the thrilling luge ride. Return to the Marae this evening for a team dinner.



THU 18 APR - DAY 7

AUCKLAND

Farewell the Marae Whanau this morning and travel north on your private coach to Auckland. Play your final game of the tour today against St Peters. Spend some time with your hosts after the game before heading to Auckland for your final night. Visit Sky Tower and enjoy views over the city before a team buffet dinner in Auckland city.

FRI 19 APR - DAY 8

SYDNEY

Check out early this morning and transfer to Auckland airport for your return flight to Sydney.
