<p><b>RELIGION</b></p> 	<p>Throughout this unit, students will learn about the books of the Bible. They will learn to identify the ways God’s people are portrayed in the Old and New Testament stories. They will learn that the Bible has key messages: Love all, Treat Others how you would like to be treated, Respect everyone. Towards the end of term, students will reflect on encounters with the Word of God and describe how it is lived out in the community.</p>	
<p><b>LITERACY</b></p> 	<p>The students will continue to attend spelling sessions where they will revise previously taught sounds and irregular words. During the last two weeks of the term, each class will review spelling lessons that students need more practise with. Students will be reviewing Vowel Teams and difficult letter sounds and combinations</p> <p>In Literacy, the students will be completing writing activities about Christmas! For example, creating a Christmas play or writing a letter to Santa. We will be learning about different writing styles in order to build their understanding of different text types and what they involve.</p>	
<p><b>MATHS</b></p> 	<p>The Grade 1s and Grade 2s will be reviewing previously taught concepts in maths such as multiplication and division, and place value. These revision lessons will be running until the end of the term, to ensure students are able to remember and review concepts from earlier in the year.</p>	
<p><b>INQUIRY</b></p> 	<p>The students will be learning about the world around us, as well as space. The students will cover stars and constellations, looking at what the constellations look like. They also focus on the life cycle of a star, and all the different stages they go through.</p>
