We are the Steering Team of the St Anthony's Kierans Creek Landcare Group which formed in 2016 following a few years of a couple of people slowly tackling the tremendous amount of weeds which had overgrown the church grounds.

St Anthony's is one of three churches in the Frenchs Forest Parish, whose name suggests that we have a close affinity with forests. We are located close to Garigal National Park and to endangered Duffy's Forest plant communities.

Kieran's Creek runs through St Anthony's and is important habitat for small birds such as the yellow robin, reptiles such as the Eastern Water Dragon, and the black swamp wallaby. Surrounding properties in Myoora Rd have been, or are in the process of, becoming alienated from surrounding natural vegetation through continued development.

We would like to offer you hope and a way to take positive action towards healing Earth our Common Home.

We invite you to join our Youth Team of volunteers in the revegetation of Kierans Creek and its surrounds as it flows across our church site at 46 Myoora Rd, Terrey Hills. With your help, St Anthony's will thus become a wildlife corridor and refuge.

Again Pope Francis says in Laudato Si' "Everyone's talents and involvement are needed to redress the damage caused by human abuse of God's creation." #14.
