

# SECOND-HAND BOOK SALE for 2026 Location: Nottingham (enter via Aitken Bvd.)

#### Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 9:00am - 12:30pm

This year, we will be continuing our second-hand book sale to support our college community. However, as the Victorian Government has mandated that all schools finalise their transition to the new Victorian Curriculum 2.0, we will be holding a second-hand book sale for VCE textbooks only. This will allow a year of transition, ensuring that students in other year levels purchase the updated textbooks required under the new curriculum.

Please note, families will be notified via Compass by **Monday, 1**<sup>st</sup> **December** regarding whether the VCE Second-Hand Book Sale will proceed. We will assess stock levels beforehand to ensure there is an adequate supply of books available for purchase on the day. In the event that stock levels are insufficient, the Second-Hand Book Sale will be cancelled.

The second-hand book sale provides parents and guardians the opportunity to sell this year's books and to buy second-hand books for 2026. The sale only deals in textbooks for Years 11 and 12 only in 2025.

#### Please note:

Damaged textbooks will not be accepted for sale and textbooks must be current editions.

When submitting textbooks for sale you must ensure that a **'Second-Hand Book Sale Form'** is completed, and each textbook has a **'Second-Hand book Label'** 'blu-tacked' inside the front cover (see subsequent pages). Textbooks will not be accepted for sale if both these tasks are not completed. Please see the attached pages for a list of sellable textbooks.

If your textbook is sold, 80% of the sale price will be refunded to you by crediting your child's school account. 20% will be retained by the College as a selling commission. This will be used by the College to fund special projects.

#### **Timeline for Book Drop Off**

<u>Students in Years 11 -12</u> will be able to drop off their textbooks at lunchtime or afterschool until 4:00pm from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> November to Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> November.

Year 12s are also able to drop them off during their exam period in the **Willandra Study Centre.** There will be a designated drop off zone.

#### **Buying Books on Sale**

The second-hand book sale will be held in the **Nottingham building** only on one day:

Payment on the day will only be via EFTPOS. No cash or cheques will be accepted.

Please ensure you bring your 2026 Mount Ridley College booklist to speed up the purchasing process. Please keep in mind that there may be a long wait time and that the event will be staffed by students and volunteers.

#### **Unsold Textbooks**

If you would like unsold textbooks returned to you, these will be available for collection from the Nottingham building between 3:10-4:30 pm from Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> – Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> December 2025.
