2024 NSW School Vaccination Program

Year 7 vaccination clinic

NSW Health will offer the following vaccinations at the school clinic;

- Year 7 Diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (dTpa) Wednesday 16th October
- Year 7 Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Tuesday 29th October
- Also; Year 8 dTpa and HPV (if not already vaccinated in Year 7)
 Year 10 & 11 Meningococcal ACWY (if not already vaccinated)

If your child is in Year 7, you can now provide online consent, via your Service NSW account, for their routine school vaccinations. Please complete this consent at least two days prior to the school clinic.

Vaccination will only be provided at school if consent has been received.

How to provide consent:

- 1. To complete online consent for your child's school vaccinations, visit: https://engage.health.nsw.gov.au/engage
- 2. Ensure the details you enter match you Medicare card details exactly, ie name spelling
- 3. Ensure you use your current Medicare number
- 4. Follow the steps to log into your existing Service NSW account.

 This is the same account you may already use to renew your driver's licence. If you don't have a Service NSW account refer to Service NSW account refer to Service NSW to create one.
- 2. Update or confirm your personal details in Service NSW as required.
- 3. Complete the School Vaccination Consent Form for your child.

No Medicare?

If you or your child do not have a Medicare card or you don't have I.T. access, consent can still be provided by requesting a paper-based consent form directly from school.

During the school vaccination clinic.

The nurse will confirm your child's identity using the online information you provided. The nurse will ask your child about serious allergies, recent vaccination and check they are well.

If your child misses the vaccination clinic?

They can be seen at the next school clinic. They do not need to go to their GP.
