| <b>RELIGION</b><br> | <p>For the next two weeks we will be focussing on <b>Prayer</b> as a way of communicating and talking to God. Students will explore formal and informal prayers and co-construct a prayer to be used during daily prayer sessions in the classroom.</p> <p>We will also be entering the liturgical season of Lent, and students will start to explore the themes of <b>Forgiveness, Mercy and Compassion</b>.</p> |   |
| <b>LITERACY</b><br> | <p>In weeks 2 &amp; 3, students will continue to expand their knowledge of sentence structure, looking at the subject and verb in a sentence. They will further extend this by focusing on the addition of adjectives to their sentences.</p> <p>Students will also investigate the different kinds of sentences and punctuation, such as statements, commands and questions.</p>                                 |   |
| <b>MATHS</b><br>    | <p><b>Statistics &amp; Data/Counting</b></p> <p>Students will pose questions to collect data and analyse this. They will also refresh their knowledge of forward and backward sequencing using two-digit and three-digit numbers.</p>   |   |
| <b>INQUIRY</b><br>  | <p>This term, students will be exploring the idea of Healthy Choices and what it means to be healthy. Over the next couple of weeks the students will learn about the Zones of Regulation and learn to talk about and express their emotions.</p>   |   |
