Travel Advice: Stop work action to impact Busways school bus services on the Central Coast on Monday 29 August

Dear Parents & Carers

The school has been advised that on **Monday 29 August 2016**, a number of **Busways** drivers in the Western Sydney and Central Coast region will stop work for four hours from **5am-9am** as a result of ongoing negotiations with the Transport Workers Union (TWU) over new enterprise agreements. To complicate matters, the stop work action may not be taken by all union members, meaning that some services will operate and some will not.

Red Bus services will not be affected.

There will be disruptions to school and route services during the stoppage. Unfortunately, Busways are unable to advise the school of which services will be operating.

Morning school services will be affected and we have received advice from Busways that parents need to make alternative transport arrangements for their children to travel to school on Monday morning. All bus services will be as normal from Monday afternoon.
