## ECIS and Allied Health

### Early Childhood Intervention Services (ECIS)

Sunbury and Cobaw Community Health's Early Childhood Intervention Service (ECIS) and allied health services work as a multidisciplinary team to support your child's health, developmental and learning needs as they grow.

Our skilled team includes physiotherapists, speech pathologists and occupational therapists.

ECIS supports children from birth to 6 years with a disability or developmental delay to develop to their full potential.

An ECIS key worker assists families to understand their child's developmental needs. This may be in the areas of speech and language, motor skills, social and emotional skills or every day living skills.

Services are tailored to meet the individual needs of the child and family, focusing on supporting the child in their every



## Our Services

### Speech Pathologist

Speech pathology can assist with:

- Difficulty being understood by other people and understanding what people say
- Frustration because the child cannot say what they want to say or cannot be understood by others
- Stuttering

### Occupational Therapist

Occupational therapy can assist with:

- Hand/eye coordination
- Fine motor skills, like doing up buttons and zippers and pencil skills
- Sleeping patterns
- Strategies to help with aggressive, impulsive behaviour or controlling emotions
- Sensory sensitivities
- Self-care, e.g. dressing, toileting

### Audiology

Our Audiologist can test your child's hearing and check the health of their middle ears.



## Our Services

### Physiotherapist

Physiotherapy can assist with:

- Premature babies or low birth weight babies
- Babies having difficulty turning their heads
- Babies not tolerating tummy time
- Babies having flat spots on the back or side of their heads, especially after 7 weeks old
- Babies and toddlers who have difficulty with rolling, sitting, crawling and walking
- Toddlers with pigeon toes, bow legs, in-rolling ankles, knock knees
- Children who have difficulties with coordination, balance, walking and running
- Frequent falls, poor balance and coordination
- Children with poor posture or children who complain of frequent muscular pain
- Children and teenagers who have any sports related injuries
