

ST ANDREWS CHRISTIAN COLLEGE 2022 NAPLAN ACHIEVEMENT REPORT FOR PARENTS


General Information

Student outcomes for the five NAPLAN domains: Reading, Writing, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation, and Numeracy, are provided as scaled scores. These scores range from 0 to 1000, and form the numeric continuum from which the ten national reporting bands are derived. The National Assessment Program scale maps student outcomes onto a ten-band continuum.

National, state and school distributions are presented as box-and-whisker plots graphed against the bands relevant for the year level as follows:

- Year 3 results will be reported in Band 1 to Band 6. Band 2 is the National Minimum Standard.
- Year 5 results will be reported in Band 3 to Band 8. Band 4 is the National Minimum Standard.
- Year 7 results will be reported in Band 4 to Band 9. Band 5 is the National Minimum Standard.
- Year 9 results will be reported in Band 5 to Band 10. Band 6 is the National Minimum Standard.

The table below gives a graphical representation of the bands, scaled scores and the relevant year levels.



The 2022 NAPLAN results are very positive – once again, St Andrews students have performed to a very high level across the range of tests and Year Levels.

Year 3:

- Over 90% of students are well above the National minimum standard in each of the five testing areas of Reading, Writing, Spelling, Numeracy and Grammar and Punctuation.
- Over 85% of students are above the State median in Grammar and Punctuation.
- In Year 3, the following percentages of students are 5 bands or more above the National minimum standard: Reading 53.7%, Writing 16.3%, Spelling 44.5%, Numeracy 29.7%, Grammar and Punctuation 55.7%.
- This is a particularly pleasing result as this cohort of students was significantly impacted by school lockdowns during Year 1 and 2.

Year 5:

- Over 90% of students are well above the National minimum standard for Reading, Spelling, Numeracy and Grammar and Punctuation.
- Over 90% of students are above the State median in Numeracy and Grammar and Punctuation.
- Over 85% of students are well above the National minimum standard in Writing.
- In Year 5, the following percentages of students are 4 bands or more above the National minimum standard: Reading 41.5%, Writing 39%, Spelling 55.6%, Numeracy 55.6%, Grammar and Punctuation 46.4%.
- 24.1% of students are significantly above the National minimum standard in Numeracy.

Year 7:

- Over 85% of students are well above the National minimum standard in each of the five testing areas.
- 22.6% of students are significantly above the National minimum standard in Numeracy.
- In Year 7, the following percentages of students are 4 bands or more above the National minimum standard: Reading 39.6%, Writing 28.3%, Spelling 50.9%, Numeracy 49%, Grammar and Punctuation 51%.
- This is a particularly pleasing result as this cohort of students was significantly impacted by school lockdowns during the important transition phase between Primary and Secondary School.


Year 9:

- Over 80% of students are well above the National minimum standard in Reading, Spelling, Numeracy and Grammar and Punctuation.
- Over 90% of students are above the State median in Numeracy.
- Over 65% of Year 9 students are well above the National minimum standard in Writing.
- In Year 9, the following percentages of students are 3 bands or more above the National minimum standard: Reading 49%, Writing 36.2%, Spelling 51.1%, Numeracy 65.9%, Grammar and Punctuation 66%.

Year 3






