MATHS: CARTESIAN PLANE

This week, our Year 5 students have been stepping into the world of coordinates as they explored the Cartesian plane in a fun and interactive way. To bring their learning to life, students put their skills to the test by playing Cartesian Plane Battleships!

Armed with grids, coordinates and plenty of strategic thinking, students plotted points, located hidden ships, and used mathematical reasoning to outsmart their opponents. There was lots of laughter, friendly competition, and those exciting "Aha!" moments as students realised just how powerful (and fun!) coordinate geometry can be.

This hands-on activity not only strengthened their understanding of ordered pairs and quadrants, but also encouraged teamwork, problem-solving and careful mathematical communication.


A fantastic effort from all our budding navigators. Year 5 has definitely mastered the map!
