SCHOOL BUS TIMETABLE CHANGES FROM TERM 1, 2026

From Term 1, 2026, a number of school buses will have new timetables. Students should check new timetables before travelling.

What services are having timetable changes?

- S1087, which travels to Wantirna College.
- S2588, which travels to Lilydale Heights College.
- S3402 and S2653, which travel to Mt Lilydale Mercy College.
- S2553, which travels to Luther College and Yarra Valley Grammar.
- S2241, which travels to Killester College.
- S1533, which travels to Fountain Gate Secondary College.
- S1522, which travels to Berwick Secondary College.
- S2236, which travels to Gleneagles Secondary College.
- S1015, which travels to Mt Waverley Secondary College.
- S1050, which travels to Highvale Secondary College.
- S1097, which travels to Wheelers Hill Secondary College.

When will new timetables be available?

New timetables will be available on Ventura's website from 12 January 2026.

When will the new timetables start?

28 January 2026, which is the first day of Term 1.

Will all school bus stops have signage?

No. Some school bus stops won't have signs and may be located across the road from public bus stops that do. Students and parents should check route maps and timetables to confirm which side of the road to wait on.

Who operates the services?

Ventura, on behalf of the Department of Transport and Planning.



How do students pay for the service?

From 1 January 2026, all passengers under 18 years of age will be able to travel for free on public transport, anytime, anywhere in Victoria.
