From UAC: HSC students: don't stress! Here's a quick and simple ATAR explainer without all the jargon.

It's important to remember that the ATAR tells you about where you are placed among your cohort (your rank); it's not a mark out of 100 or a percentage. Its only purpose is to help universities select students for their courses.

Of the 54,894 NSW students who received an ATAR in 2020:

- only 46 students (less than 1%) received an ATAR of 99.95
- 50.3% received an ATAR of at least 70.00
- 65.6% received an ATAR of at least 60.00.
