

WELCOME TO TERM 4

LITERACY

This term, students will focus on learning about information reports. They will practise researching a topic, organising facts clearly, and using specific vocabulary to explain what something is, what it looks like, and how it works. Students will also use images or other visual elements to help make their reports more interesting and easier to understand. By the end of the unit, they will create their own short information reports to share clear, factual information with others.

NUMERACY

This term, students will focus on learning multiplication and division, starting with facts for twos and using strategies like doubling and halving. They will explore how multiplication and division are connected, practise using terms like "double," "halve," "multiply by 2," and "divide by 2," and notice patterns in number charts. Students will solve real world problems using arrays, equal groups, diagrams, and skip counting, including situations with money or sharing items equally. By the end of the unit, they will confidently apply these strategies to solve everyday multiplication and division problems.
