1 in 4 young people volunteer

Key findings from Volunteers Australia Youth Volunteering research underscore the importance of youth involvement in volunteering:

- In 2022, 25% of individuals aged 18-24 engaged in formal volunteering, reflecting their compassion and responsibility.
- Volunteers aged 18-29 are prominent in key sectors driving positive change 37.8% in animal welfare and 28.8% in health organisations.
- Young volunteers are inclined towards virtual volunteering, demonstrating adaptability and eagerness to impact causes online.
