RELIGION	Throughout this unit, students will learn about the books of the Bible. They will learn to identify the ways God's people are portrayed in the Old and New Testament stories. They will learn that the Bible has key messages: Love all, Treat Others how you would like to be treated, Respect everyone. Towards the end of term, students will reflect on encounters with the Word of God and describe how it is lived out in the community.			
LITERACY	The students will continue to attend daily spelling sessions where they will revise previously taught sounds and irregular words. They will also learn to read, write and spell new sounds and irregular words. The grade 2s will be focusing on saying and spelling the sounds: -ish, -y, -ness and -ment. The grade 1s will be focusing on saying and spelling the sound: un-, the doubling rule with -ed/-ing and -er/-est and the drop -e rule.			
	In Literacy, we will continue to read and focus on The Velveteen Rabbit. The students will continue to decode new words, expand and develop their sentence writing, and they will also focus on the different features within this story. They will be reviewing narrative writing and using their knowledge of narratives to help them focus on features of the text, such as characters and figurative language.			
MATHS	The Grade 2s will be learning about fractions. They will be learning to recognise and describe one-half as one of 2 equal parts of a whole and connect halves, quarters and eighths through repeated halving.
