Not all household waste can be put in your kerbside bins. Community Recycling Centres offer a FREE and EASY solution for the disposal of household problem waste such as paints, gas bottles, motor oils, batteries, smoke detectors and fluorescent globes and tubes.

Many of these materials can be reused and recycled if processed correctly. Recycling helps our environment because it saves water, energy and natural resources.

How to recycle other household items:

- Visit www.cleanout.com.au to find your nearest CleanOut event to safely dispose of your household chemicals.
- Return unwanted medicine to your local pharmacy for safe disposal.
 - Drop off your used or empty laser and inkjet printer cartridges at participating Australia Post, Officeworks, JB Hi-Fl and Cartridge World stores.
- Businesses are not eligible to use the Community Recycling Centres. Find out where to recycle business waste at www.businessrecycling.com.au
- Recycle plastic bags and other soft plastic packaging at major supermarkets. Visit www.redcycle.net.au for more information.

Only household quantities accepted 20kg or 20L maximum container size. Please transport your materials carefully. Dangerous goods and items other than those listed will not be accepted.
