## Career Trends

### School Based Traineeships OR UniPrep

During a recent career professionals meeting, the recommendation was made that senior students should consider a school-based traineeship/pre apprenticeship as their first choice, INSTEAD OF doing a school-based UniPrep course.

Traineeships and pre apprenticeships get your foot in the door of an industry, you get to know people, and you find out about the culture of the job. By leaving a positive impression, school-based trainees and pre-apprentices can position themselves for selection into competitive roles, such as electrical apprenticeships.

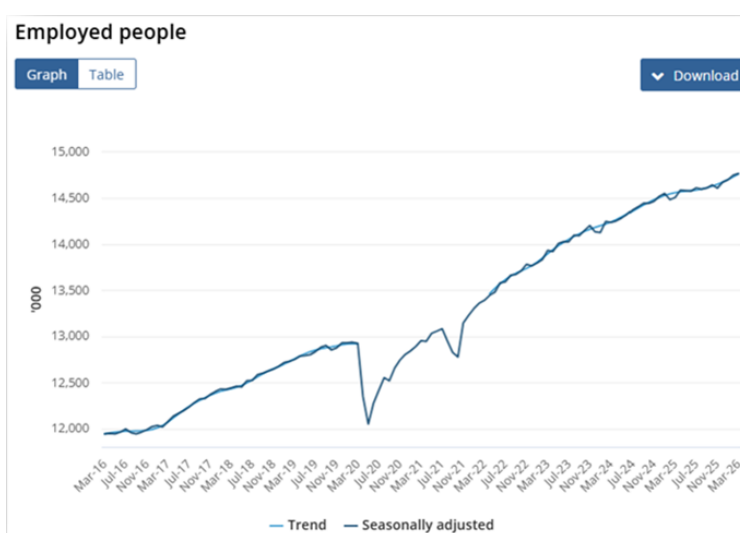


# Employment Statistics

## Australian Bureau of Statistics March Labour Force Statistics

In trend terms, in March 2026:

- unemployment rate remained at 4.3%.
- participation rate remained at 66.8%.
- employment increased to 14,762,800.
- employment to population ratio remained at 64.0%.
- underemployment rate remained at 5.9%. monthly hours worked increased to 2,015 million

## Jobs and Skills Australia Internet Vacancy Index March Report

Over the month, advertisements increased by 1.2%, with increases across most major occupation groups, skill level groups and all states and territories.

Job ad numbers increased compared with the same time last year. Advertisement numbers continue at relatively high levels historically.

**Western Australia** had 27,800 job ads, up 630 which was 2.3%. That's 1700 up or 6.3% over the year.

## Bankwest Curtin Economics Centre Labour Market Update

Our economists assess resilient labour market conditions amid global uncertainty and delayed signals on inflation and interest rates.

### Still a waiting game for data to reflect impact of US-Iran conflict

'Steady', 'uneventful', 'calm before the storm'. Commentators were left vying for alternative ways of saying the March labour force figures harboured no implications for the direction of the economy or policy settings.

Lags in the availability of key economic data are creating a frustrating waiting game for hard evidence on the impact of the US-Iran war on the Australian economy. The impact on inflation is what everyone is itching to know. The latest inflation figure - 3.7 per cent for February - predates the jump in fuel prices.

- **Modest rise in employment and fall in participation combine to keep the unemployment rate steady at 4.3 per cent.**
- **Jobs data yet to reflect impact of fuel crisis, but data on vacancies and hours worked point to resilience in labour demand.**

## Apprenticeship data from NCVER

The latest National Council for Vocational Education Research data shows:

- **trade apprenticeship commencements increased** by almost 18% in the quarter to September 2025, compared with the same quarter in 2024. (This is down almost 10% over the year to September and non-trade commencements are down just over 18%)
- **trade contract completions increased** by almost 12% in the 12 months to September 2025. Across key construction trades, thousands more apprentices completed their training during the year. The most notable were Bricklayers, and Carpenters and Joiners contributing 9,050 completions (an increase of just over 23%), Plumbers with 4,900 completions (a rise of just under 18%) and Electricians with 9,485 new completions (an increase of just under 40%).

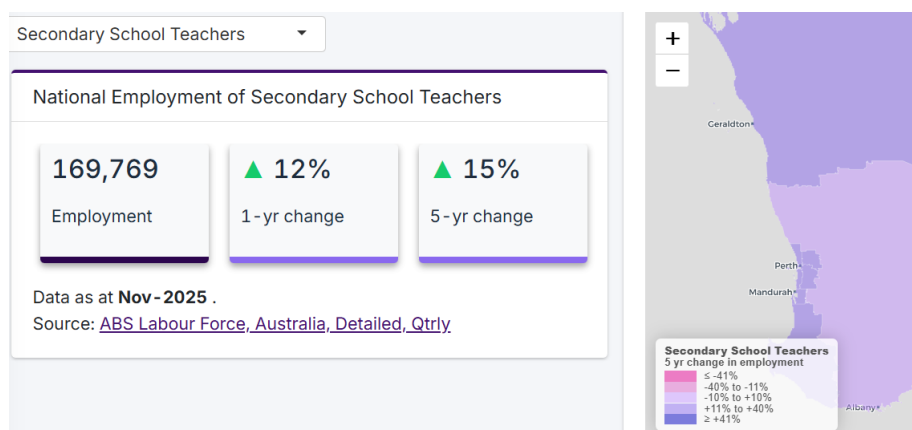

The Casper test is a situational judgement test that assesses an applicant's personal and professional characteristics through open-ended questions. It's used by many universities, particularly for programs like medicine, dentistry, and education, to evaluate candidates beyond academic achievements. The test presents scenarios and asks applicants to explain their approach and reasoning. The test is currently being used as part of the Curtin University application criteria for their undergraduate medical program.

If you're planning to apply for Veterinary Medicine in 2027, sitting the 2026 Casper test is an essential part of your application. Murdoch University requires all Veterinary Science applicants to complete the undergraduate Casper assessment, with 2026 test dates scheduled for:

- 14 May
- 21 June

Casper is an online situational judgement test that takes around 65–85 minutes and assesses qualities like communication, empathy, problem-solving and resilience, attributes that are crucial for future veterinarians. You can only sit the test once per admissions cycle, so we strongly recommend registering early (at least three days before your chosen test date) to avoid missing out and ensure your application remains valid.

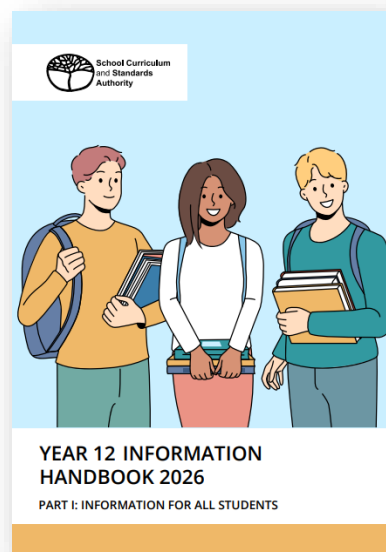

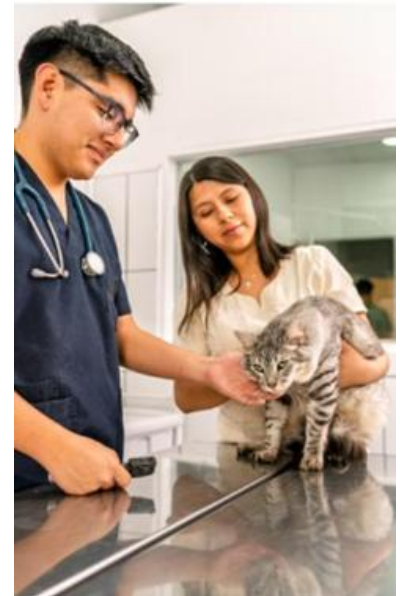

## Junior wage changes

The Fair Work Commission has announced upcoming changes to junior wages under the:

- Retail Award
- Fast Food Award

## Watch out for Job Scams

Employment fraud among people aged 24 and under has more than doubled this year. The Australian Government has [ScamWatch](#) website that reports Jobs and employment scams.

- Stop and check any job offer that requires you to pay money to make money. It could be a scam.

In April the [ABC](#) reported this case:

*Manish Bholan moved to Perth from Nepal six months ago and has been looking for work since.*

*The 23-year-old found a cleaning job advertised on a Facebook group, but instead of finding work unknowingly fell into an employment scam.*

*After responding to the job ad he was asked by a "recruiter" to fill out a form and pay \$345 for "the form processing".*

*"And I paid for it to get a new job," he told the ABC.*

*"Later he asked around [additional] \$450 for the dress [work clothing], and I realised it was a scam."*
