THE BLESSED RICVERA MIDDLE SCHOOL MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP 2022

The Music Scholarship has been named after Blessed Ricvera who was a woman of noble birth and marriage who became the first Norbertine nun in 1121. After her death, Blessed Ricvera's grave became the site of miracles, most notably for the miraculous flowers that grew there.

The College offers Middle School Music Scholarships to students already enrolled and accepted for study at St Norbert College in Year 7 in 2022 and are offered to students of high musical ability and/or potential.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

Middle School Music Scholarships cover full or 50% instrumental or vocal fees up to the value of \$3000, and is tenable for Years 7-9 subject to a satisfactory review of student performance each year. A scholarship audition is conducted in Term 3 for Year 6 students.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection of a suitable student includes the following criteria:

- An audition song/piece on voice or an instrument of choice
- An interview including aural (listening) and theory testing
- School and Music reports

Please note that while you are welcome to audition on piano, voice or percussion, Music Scholarships are rarely awarded for these instruments.

Special consideration will be given to students with a sound musical background who show an interest in learning a new instrument selected by the College. No previous experience on the new instrument is needed.

EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS

- Commit to regular attendance at instrumental lessons exclusively with a St Norbert College instrumental tutor and demonstrate progress on the instrument. External lessons on this instrument would be in conflict of the intent of this scholarship
- Be a member and perform with an associated College Ensemble
- Be willing to perform as a soloist in any of the College's music events including the Recital Afternoons, Music Night and the Catholic Performing Arts Festival
- Participate in year-long classroom Music studies in Years 8 and 9
- Maintain excellent academic, behaviour and attendance records at the College
