HOW TO USE THE WHEELER'S EPLATFORM WEBSITE

Go to <https://mgc.wheelers.co/> . You can also find this link on the School Intranet.

You can sign in using your Compass username (e.g. **ABC0001**)

The default password to login is **Library1**



The eBooks are available 24/7, so if you need a book on the weekend and the school library isn't available, this is where you should go.



HOW TO USE THE WHEELER'S EPLATFORM APP


You can download the application on your Apple or Android device. Open the app store and search **ePlatform by Wheelers** and install the app.



Once it has installed, open the application and select 'Find your library'. Search for Melbourne Girls' College in the list and select it.



Next, you'll need to select the hamburger menu on the left of the screen and select 'Sign In'.
