2020 Primary Swimming Carnival

Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back to 2020. Our first Primary sports event of the year is the Primary Swimming Carnival, which has certainly become a great way to start the year! The carnival will be held at the Manning Aquatic Centre on **Thursday January 30**.

The buses will depart from the College at 9:20am and arrive back at the College before 3pm, in time for regular buses home. All costs for buses and pool entry will be covered by the College.

Students in Kindergarten and Year 1 will not be attending the carnival. Students in Year 2 should only attend if they turn 8 in 2019, **AND** are capable of swimming 50m **AND** intend to compete on the day. Year 2 students are not required to attend the swimming carnival, but may if they would like to. Year 2 students **NOT** attending the carnival will be required to attend school as normal.

If you believe your child qualifies for multiclass events due to a disability, please contact Mr Warner so we can discuss opportunities in swimming and other sports.

Please ensure your child has appropriate sports uniform or house colour dress-ups, sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, appropriate footwear, food and drinks. If you are unsure of your child's house please contact your class teacher. The pool's canteen will be in operation throughout the day.

Girls are required to wear one piece swimmers, where the midriff is covered, in accordance with College Policy. Both boys and girls are encouraged to wear rash shirts particularly in free play times.

All students will be encouraged to enter at least one race. The 50 metre freestyle is a good choice for those looking to only compete once. After lunch the lanes may be taken out and all students may have the opportunity for free swimming if time permits.

Parents/Carers are invited to come along and make this a fantastic, family day! Feel free to get into the fun of the day by dressing in your child's house colours. There may be an opportunity for a staff verses parents race, so bring your swimmers and let Mr Warner know if you'd like to compete.

Please complete and return the permission note attached to the class teacher ASAP.

If you are dropping off or picking up your child directly to/from the pool, please ensure you make contact with their class teacher on arrival/departure.
