volunteers are requested to register your participation online at: http://www.ccam.org.au/events/category/30/child-safe-training The training session is expected to take about 2½ hours. There will be no charge as it is sponsored by the Diocese of Sale. It includes a training booklet, tea and coffee.

CHILD SAFEGUARDING CORNER: The best protection for the safety of our children is their awareness of the dangers of potential abuse in various forms. In this respect, it is of paramount importance for parents themselves to be fully aware of such dangers and to educate their children to them. Below are some shocking statistics we should all pay attention to:

- 12% of female and 4.5% of males report having been sexually abused before the age of 15 years.
- 2 girls and 1 boy in a typical Australian primary school class of 22 kids, will report being sexually abused before the age of 15 years.
- In 11% of these cases the child was abused by a stranger.
- In 89% of these cases the child was abused by someone they knew.
- 45% were abused by a relative (i.e. parent, step-parent, grandparent, sibling, uncle, aunty or cousin).
- 47% were abused by a friend, neighbour, acquaintance or were otherwise known to them

FIRST READING

Isaiah 35:1-6,10

Let the wilderness and the dry-lands exult, let the wasteland rejoice and bloom, let it bring forth flowers like the jonguil, let it rejoice and sing for joy. The glory of Lebanon is bestowed on it, the splendour of Carmel and Sharon; they shall see the glory of the Lord, the splendour of our God. Strengthen all weary hands, steady all trembling knees and say to all faint hearts, 'Courage! Do not be afraid. 'Look, your God is coming, vengeance is coming, the retribution of God; he is coming to save you.' Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, the ears of the deaf unsealed, then the lame shall leap like a deer and the tongues of the dumb sing for joy; for those the Lord has ransomed shall return. They will come to Zion shouting for joy, everlasting joy on their faces; joy and gladness will go with them and sorrow and lament be ended.

As the messengers were leaving, Jesus began to talk to the people about John: 'What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed swaying in the breeze? No? Then what did you go out to see? Yes, I tell you, and much more than a prophet: he is the one of whom scripture says: Look, I am going to send my messenger before you; he will prepare your way before you. I tell you solemnly, of all the children born of women, a greater than John the Baptist has never been seen; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he is'.
