FLOREAT/WEMBLEY PARISH SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF RECONCILIATION, EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

We offer our PREP (Parish Religious Education Program) for those children in our Parish

for those children in our Parish who do not attend a Catholic School. These children must to attend weekly classes for 10 weeks on Wednesday afternoons from 4.00pm – 5.00pm to receive the necessary instruction to prepare them for the Sacrament they will be receiving.

Enrolments for these classes close on Monday 11 February 2019

by which time your completed Sacramental Programme Enrolment Form and accompanying money must be received.

PREP Classes commence Wednesday 20 February
 4.00pm – 5.00pm in the Parish Centre, rear of 47
 Peebles Rd, Floreat. Children must attend <u>all</u> classes.

Children in our Parish who attend a Catholic School will receive instruction to prepare them for the Sacrament as part of their Religious Education Program at their school.

These children must enrol at the Parish to receive the Sacraments.

Enrolment Form and accompanying money must be received by Monday, 11 February 2019.

Where Catholic School children have missed the preparation for a particular Sacrament, they are invited to join the PREP.

According to our Archdiocesan Guidelines – Children are prepared to receive the Sacraments as follows:

Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation) in Year 3 Sacrament of Eucharist (First Communion) in Year 4 Sacrament of Confirmation in Year 6.

In order to maintain the uniqueness of each, only one Sacrament should be received each year under this Program.

"Parish" refers to where you live (Parish Boundaries), where you worship and are registered as a parishioner.

Dress requirements (especially for First Holy Communion Day)

Girls - Best dress, however most still prefer traditional white - long or short. Veils are not recommended as they are awkward if not securely attached.

If head decoration is required, a spray of small flowers or a hair comb or clip is more practical.

Boys - Smart, neat clothes. Most choose shirt, long or short trousers, tie, jumper, jacket or vest.

DUTY OF CARE STATEMENT and PRIVACY POLICY

The FLOREAT WEMBLEY PARISH has a duty of care to children attending the after-school Parish Religious Education Program. Your children are in the care of responsible adults who have a 'Working with Children Check Card'. Our parish catechists are dedicated volunteers who also have family or other commitments after classes. Therefore, we thank you in anticipation of your support and co-operation.

Your child's safety and wellbeing are most important and we seek your support and co-operation.

- Classes are held during the first and second terms of the school year on Wednesday afternoons from 4.00pm 5.00pm over 10 weeks only; your child MUST attend each lesson..
- Classes start at 4.00pm promptly. PLEASE do not be late. Should your child arrive before 4.00pm and there is no catechist to supervise, it is your responsibility to supervise your child until a catechist arrives. The child must stay with you during this time.
- We ask that you collect your child/children promptly at 5.00pm.
- It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to drop off and pick up their child/children. If you are delayed in picking up your child, then you should make alternative arrangements.
- In cases of emergency, contact the Parish Office on 9387 1158.
- As a safety precaution, we ask that you follow the protocol of the parking area and ENTER via PEEBLES ROAD and EXIT via GRANTHAM STREET.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that your child attends classes. If your child is unable to attend then you should contact the Parish Office on 9387 1158 or floreat@perthcatholic.org.au
