Campers attend a transformational weekend-long program free of charge that combines fun, physical challenges with grief education and emotional support.

To qualify to attend:

- A child has been affected by the death of a parent, sibling or legal guardian
- Is aged between 7-17 years
- The parent, sibling or guardian must have been deceased for a minimum of 6 months
