






Please note: Rooms H2.1, H2.2, H2.24 & H2.25 are small specialist tutorial rooms set up for the Deaf School. These should not be used. There is also no entry to the English and HASS Staff Office.

Some corridor spaces are quite large and are numbered, for example the large corridor space between H2.20 and H2.22 is numbered H2.21, this accounts for the missing room numbers. One or more of these spaces could be used as an adjudicator hub and/or info point.

Classrooms should be returned to the way they were found including:

- Desks and chairs organised as they were found
- Whiteboard cleared (since teams will be sharing prep rooms, best if neither team uses the whiteboard)
- All air-con/heaters/fans and lights turned off
- Rubbish in bins

## CAMPUS MAP




