Throughout this year, schools have been affected by industrial action whilst the Australian Education Union (AEU) and the Victorian Government have engaged in negotiations. New Learning Areas:

Performing Arts & Auslan

A curriculum score is not included for Semester One in Performing Arts or Auslan, as both subjects were newly introduced this year. Initial teaching has focused on building foundational skills, engagement, and subject knowledge, which are essential before assessing against year-level standards. Due to the limited time and evidence available, an accurate teacher judgement could not yet be made. Curriculum scores will be provided in Semester Two, 2026.

Media Arts:

This semester, we have newly incorporated Media Arts into STEM (Yrs 3-6). Media Arts in the Victorian Curriculum enables students to create and explore media such as film, photography and digital content, developing skills in storytelling, technology use and creative expression. It supports students' ability to analyse and evaluate media, helping them understand how media messages interact with audiences. As a result, no learning growth (represented by progression dashes) will be shown. Only a 'solid dot' will appear on these reports.
