I am writing to you regarding some exciting opportunities that are being presented with the current state government initiative **Pick My Project**, and specifically to highlight to you three projects that will benefit directly the education of young people attending Castlemaine Secondary College.

The **Pick My Project** initiative has 20 million dollars to spread across successful projects throughout the state. It has shortlisted over 2000 projects in Victoria, and over 170 projects are within a 30 km radius of Castlemaine.

In order to participate you must set up an account on-line and then select three projects. The instructions are on the reverse side of this sheet. Although I have highlighted the three projects I think benefit our students directly, I encourage you to look through the list of all projects on-line and select three that you find appealing.
