Ride pass prices are as follows: \$35 for one child \$65 for two children \$95 for three children \$30 for any additional child beyond 3 kids in the family

\$40 for all ride passes (purchased on the day) \$5 for individual rides (purchased on the day) Pre-school Children aged 4 and under are FREE.

<u>Terms and conditions</u> – Children must be in the same family, however, purchases on behalf of friends/cousins external to the school may be purchased in the one transaction. (eg if you have 2 kids in your family plus 2 cousins attending, you may purchase a 3 child pass, plus an additional \$30 pass)

Rides are free for children under 4 years of age, however not all rides are suitable for them. Younger children must be supervised by parents at all times. There is no charge for parents accompanying a younger child.

Older children/teenagers are welcome on the rides. They must have a ticket and be mindful of the younger kids around.

Parents are welcome on the rides, and will also need to purchase a wrist band, unless they are accompanying a pre-schooler.
