

## Fidget and Fiddle Muff Crochet Pattern

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### **Approximate Size:**

11" long and 11" around (5.5" lying flat)

### **Skill Level:**

Easy

## **Materials Needed:**

Worsted weight acrylic yarn, I used Bernat Pop in Full Spectrum 6mm (US J) crochet hook Tapestry needle Miscellaneous buttons or other fiddle items

### **Abbreviations:**

ch (chain)
hdc (half double crochet)
rnd (round)
sc (single crochet)
sc2tog (single crochet 2 together)
sl (slip stitch)
st (stitch/stitches)

#### **Pattern Notes:**

Chains do not count as a stitch.

Muff and lining is crocheted as one long piece.

Pattern is completed in rounds.

Pattern is easily adjusted to larger or smaller sizes using different size hooks or adding or subtracting rows.

### **Instructions:**

Ch 31

SI into first chain being careful not to twist chain

Rnd 1-40: Ch 2, hdc around, sl. (30 st)



Change colors as needed, Pictured muff has 6 changes: after rounds 5, 10, 15, 25, 30 and 35.



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Insert one end into the muff for the lining, folding muff in half, matching edges.



## **Cuffs:**

Slip new color for cuffs onto one end of muff.

Rnd 1: Sc aound (30 st)

Rnd 2: (Sc, sc2tog) around (20 st)

Rnd 3-5: Sc around (20 st)

Repeat for other end of the muff.

## Rose (make 2):

Ch 31
Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook,
Sc in next ch, ch 2, sc in same ch
Repeat for each ch.
Spiral chain and sew together with slightly
larger rounds on the bottom, and tight rounds
on the top.

## Curls (make 3):

Ch 20, turn, 2sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> and each ch.

## Finishing:

Sew on your embellishments. *Ensure they are* secure and do not pose a choking or other hazard to the recipient. Embellishment ideas:

- String beads with different textures, materials and weights
- Roses
- Curls: Sew 3 curls together and cover with a button
- Pompoms
- Metal washers or chains
- Small soft brush with a hole in the handle for sewing on
- Shower curtain rings
- Rings
- Fun shaped buttons
- Soft side of hook and loop tape
- Fabric, lace and ribbons
- Key chains
- Small toys
- Fidget spinners
- Old keys and locks
- Small stuffed animals
- Bells

Sew in ends. Check for safety.
